Introduction

The sixth annual Listening Summit, organized by Pepperdine University with the support of Fudan University, is an opportunity for students from different parts of the world to spend a weekend learning from each other as they discuss, debate and analyze topics of global importance. Previous summits have focused on topics like Sino-US relations, international education, urbanization and climate change. This year's theme revolves around the complex topic of US-China International Relations. The U.S. presidential election is on November 4, less than a week before the Summit, so students will be able to digest the results of the election and analyze how the new U.S. president will affect America's relationship with China going forward. This topic will also provide American and Chinese students to learn how people from other countries view their political systems. The organizer will provide accommodations, meals and transportations during the Listening Summit. Students interested in this topic from Pepperdine University and Fudan University are encouraged to apply.
